February 2025

March 2025

On the 11th March, Shropshire Homes and Telford and Wrekin Council met to discuss the latest scheme approach. The feedback from TWC was positive, saying it was the most organic scheme to date on the site.



April 2025

With the layout evolving following feedback from the discussed meetings, new sketches were presented to TWC and Historic England on the 9th April 2025, with overall positive feedback for the new proposals.



December 2024

On 20th December 2024, a Pre-Application was submitted by Shropshire Homes Ltd to gain pre-application advice from Telford and Wrekin Council.



• Re-using the Wing Shop may be viewed favourably
 • The Sweetshop should be restored and retained, following example from similar homes in the area
 • Utilising the Compressor House as part of the interpretation could work well
 • Incorporating the route of the new lightweight railway system was seen as a positive
 • Important to monitor carefully the archaeology in the NW corner of the site when forming the new watercourse
 • Look into the future management of the outfall land – the surface water outfall proposed for the south of the site.

March 2025
